

Northwest Spay & Neuter Center's mission is to promote and provide affordable, high-quality spay and neuter services for cats, dogs, and rabbits in an effort to stop the killing of animals due to overpopulation.

Highlights for 2012 include:

- Performed 11,000 surgeries and assisted over 5,600 pet owners and caretakers, 98% of whom are low-income individuals and families.
- Provided services for residents of 24 of 39 counties in Washington State.
- Partnered with 41 animal welfare organizations, providing spay/neuter services for their adoptable animals, and co-sponsored further reduced fee programs.
- Started offering affordable spay/neuter services for rabbits.
- Offered subsidized surgeries for over 1,000 animals at high risk of euthanasia in shelters, such as feral/free roaming cats and Pit Bull-type dogs.
- 50% fee reduction for feral/free roaming cat package of services, "Project Catnip".
- Clinic is completely self-sufficient and operates in the black, with fundraising dollars applied directly to further reducing fees and expanding our programs.
- Rebranded and renamed the organization to better convey to our clients and supporters the service we offer to the community.
- Purchased and renovated a building that boasts nearly three times the space of our previous location and will allow us to perform up to 30,000 surgeries annually. The center offers individualized rooms for owned and shelter dogs, owned and shelter cats, feral/free roaming cats, and rabbits; an expanded lobby with separate dog and cat/rabbit entrances; state-of-the-art surgery suites that are significantly larger and designed for maximum efficiency, and convenient access to Pierce Transit bus stops and the I-5 corridor.

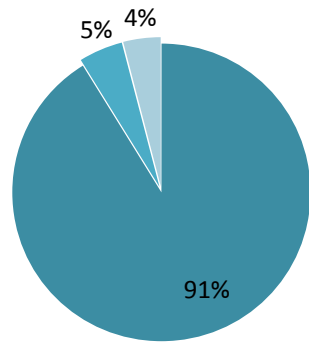

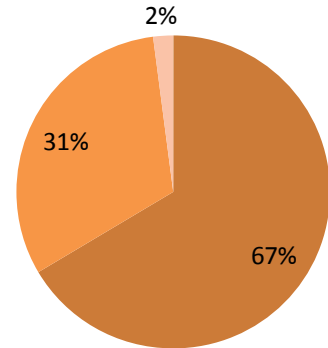
